No Kings Seattle March 28 Neighbors Fighting Fascism: ICE Out

SEATTLE – Americans bow to no kings. Seattle is rising to join in the largest nationwide mass mobilization yet to stop the fascism and corruption of the Trump regime.

Trump's MAGA regime is starting to crack. He's losing in court on multiple fronts and his illegal war is wildly unpopular. As public defiance grows, the Trump administration is ramping up its cruelty - but the people continue to demonstrate that neighbors supporting neighbors is one of our strongest forms of resistance.

Our Seattle resistance keeps growing. More than 20 Seattle area organizations are uniting for this massive No Kings March. In April, 25,000 of us said Hands Off. In June, 70,000 marched in one of the largest protests Seattle has ever seen. October saw 90,000 people marching in the streets of Seattle.

Join our peaceful protest on March 28. Bring your friends and neighbors. Together, we are the firewall against dictatorship. Afterwards, find your neighborhood activist team at Seattle Center to continue to make a difference and protect our communities.
